Assignments:

5. Complete the Multiple Choice *Reformation Exam*.
6. Organise a Reformation Bible study group at your school, college, church, workplace or home. Report on your experiences - what you learned (1 - 2 pages).
7. Organise Reformation Day events such as a Reformation Sunday service and a Reformation film screening. Report on the responses you encountered (1 - 2 pages).
